Ahli Arab Hospital, Gaza (Director: Suhaila Tarazi)

Please pray that through the Community and Development and Child Wellbeing Program, caregivers would feel more empowered to make decisions for their children's health, recognise the signs of early malnutrition and get the support they need for their children.

Spafford Children's Center, East Jerusalem (CEO: Shahd Souri)

Give thanks for the five days of training in cooperation with Pal Vision Organisation for 40 mothers from Spafford Children's Center. The training addressed domestic violence issues and the psychosocial disorders that may be present in their children. Please pray for these women and children; pray that they would be receptive to the training and receive the support they need for themselves and their children.

Anglican Church Melanesia, Vanuatu (Project leader: Ethel George)

We pray for the upcoming cyclone season in October. We pray for the protection of communities in Vanuatu during this time. We particularly pray for those most vulnerable including women, children and those living with a disability that they would be protected from harm and abuse - before, during and after disaster strikes.
